Qualitative Analysis

A. The increase in total capital is primarily attributed to profits generated during the year

B. The leverage ratio remains comfortably above the minimum threshold of 9.72%, highlighting effective risk management practices

C. LCR and NSFR in Q2-2025 still above the minimum regulatory limits, indicating sufficiency of the Bank's liquidity

D. Overall, these metrics suggest that the bank is in a strong financial position with sufficient capital and liquidity to navigate potential challenges in the market
